Dear Sir,

I refer to your recent telephone conversation with Mr. A.J. Watts, the Assistant Under Secretary of this Department, in regard to the construction of a stone wall along the north side of Camperdown Cemetery.

From an examination of the site it has become evident that the only practicable access available to the contractor is over the Memorial Park land, and removal of the existing temporary fence (which is the property of the Department) will be unavoidable.

It is intended that the contractor's vehicles shall enter the Park at the western gate and proceed along, and as near as possible to, the foundations of the north wall except that, in connection with the construction of the east end of the wall, access will be obtained through the garden belonging to the sexton's cottage.

As the contractor has been forced to stop cutting stone pending a decision in this matter, I would earnestly request that you ascertain from the Trustees as soon as possible whether they concur in the above proposals.



In connection with your recent advice in regard to this matter, I desire to bring the following circumstances to your notice.

When the late Bishop Hilliard and myself were asked to become Trustees of the Camperdown Memorial Rest Park Trust, the Act of Parliament was drafted so as to specifically include our names therein, the clear intention being to ensure that these appointments were unaffected by age limits normally applying to trustees in other instances.

This meant that the Bishop and myself would be Trustees until our decease unless of course we resigned or were removed from office by the Synod or Standing Committee, as provided by the Act, but in no other circumstance.

Apart from this, we were also informed at the time that the Trustee Act, being a general Act, does not override or repeal a special Act and thus the appointment of Bishop Hilliard and P.W. Gledhill would not be affected by the provision of the said Trustee Act.

Lastly Section 2 clause 2B of the Camperdown Cemetery (Amendment) Act 1950 provides that upon the commencement of this section the Right Rev. William George Hilliard, Bishop Co-adjutor, Diocese of Sydney, and Percy Walter Gledhill Esq., shall be deemed to have been appointed members of the Trust pursuant to this paragraph and shall, subject to this section hold office accordingly.

The only circumstances specified under the Act in which my office is to be vacated are:

- (a) death
- (b) resignation
- (c) removal from office by Synod or standing committee.

Also, it will be noted that under Act No.15 1950, the Trust does not come under the provisions of the Public Parks Act 1912.

Subject: Laying of P.M.G. ducts across
Camperdown Memorial Rest Park.

This Division is committed to provide additional ducts between the enlarged Newtown Telephone Exchange and Camperdown. The planned route was from Eliza Street onto the northern footway of Lennox Street westwards along this footway to the north eastern corner of Lennox and Australia Streets, then northwards along the eastern footway of Australia Street.


Investigations have revealed that at some future date Lennox Street may be widened on its north side. Consequently the laying of ducts in Lennox Street would be impracticable, and the only alternative is to lay these pipes through the Camperdown Memorial Rest Park.

The size of the trench through the park would be two (2) feet wide by no more than four (4) feet deep. A manhole four (4) feet wide and four (4) feet deep would be required in the high part of the Park, and another on the proposed new footway of Lennox Street.

Telephone cables would be pulled into these ducts at the rate of approximately one every twelve months.

It would be appreciated if this proposal could be discussed by the Trust and the results of this discussion forwarded to the above Office.
